Early Stage 1 Overview Term 2 2012



Literacy

Reading: Students will participate in The Jolly Phonics program, where they will continue to learn the sounds used in the English language. Students will continue with The L3 (Language, Learning and Literacy) Program, where they will be involved in daily guided reading activities. Children will also be involved in a variety of modelled and independent reading activities.

Writing: Students will do explicit handwriting lessons using NSW Foundation Handwriting. They will be involved in daily writing activities involving modelled, guided and independent activities.

Talking and Listening: Students will be participating in news groups and class discussions focussing on using formal language. Children are encouraged to follow the weekly topic lists given at the beginning of each term.

Mathematics

In Early Stage 1, there is a strong emphasis on the language used in Mathematics. Students will count forward and backwards in the range of 0-30 and represent numbers to 20 with objects, pictures, numerals and words. They will learn to recognise, describe, create and continue repeating patterns.

Students will use the language of money and learn about 2D and 3D shapes. They will do simple grouping and sharing activities and model addition and subtraction problems. Students will compare different lengths, areas, volumes and capacities. Mathematical learning also takes place in craft activities and developmental play.
